CANADIAN FEDERATION OF STUDENTS

- Free and accessible post-secondary education
- Support student mobility and transfer credits
- Desire to emulate British Colombia transfer system
- Unique realities for various caucuses and constituencies help inform our advocacy





STUDENT INSIGHTS



- Lack of information
 - Options are unclear and not properly defined
 - Many students do not know they are transfer students





STUDENT INSIGHTS



- Lack of consistency
 - Difficult to engage in process
 - May find it easier to start over rather than transfer





STUDENT INSIGHTS



- Time consumption
 - Difficult to navigate bureaucracy
 - Duplication of time and resources





PRIORITIES



- Effectively disseminate information
- Focus on priority students groups
 - International
 - Racialized
 - Indigenous
 - Part time
 - Northern





NEXT STEPS

- Create a comprehensive outreach and communication strategy
- Must be informed by unique experiences of priority groups
- Increase accessibility for marginalized learners to access and engage in the transfer credit process





NEXT STEPS

- We need a culture shift
- End the commodification of post-secondary education
- Standardize process across institutions
